Course Overview

This 12-credit Research Methodology course (Hybrid Mode) is designed to equip students with the essential skills, tools, and ethical understanding required to conduct social science research. The course blends theoretical insights with practical applications to empower future researchers and scholars.

Important Instructions:

- 1. The coursework is of 12 credits (180 Hours).
- 2. The coursework will be conducted in hybrid mode.
- 3. The coursework will be conducted in 2 phases. Ist phase will be conducted in June 2025 (Details are provided) in offline mode and IInd phase will be conducted on October-November 2025 in online mode.
- 4. Phase II will include assignment, presentation and written test.
- 5. Coursework certificate will be provided only after successful completion of both the phases.
- 6. Coursework will begin every day at 8.30 am. Library hours will be from 8.30 am to 12.30 pm.
- 7. 12.30 to 1 pm will be lunch break. (Candidates need to do their lunch arrangements)
- 8. 1 to 5.15 pm will be session time. (Details are provided in the above table)
