Coaching Classes for entry in services for students belonging to SC/ST / OBC (non-creamy layer) & Minorities and Weaker Sections

1. Introduction

The well-being and development of the Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), OBC (non-creamy layer) and Minorities are important indicators of the strength and success of a democratic society. Specific provisions have been made to improve the status of these groups, socially and educationally, so that they can take their rightful place in society. Representation of the groups in All India / State / Provincial Services and equivalent positions in the private sector is an indicator of how far the country has been successful to equip them so that they are in a position to safeguard their own interests.

In order to prepare students belonging to SC / ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) and Minority communities to get gainful employment in Central and other services mentioned above, our college with the financial help of UGC conducts the Coaching classes for entry in services for SC / ST & Minorities students.

2. Objectives

The basic objective of the coaching scheme is to prepare students belonging to SC / ST/ OBC (non-creamy layer) and Minority communities to get gainful employment in Group 'A', 'B' or 'C' Central services, State services or equivalent positions in the private sector. The coaching under the scheme should be oriented for particular examinations conducted for selection to services, such as the IAS, State Public Services, Bank recruitment, etc. The coaching may be focused, taking into consideration the specific requirements of a particular competitive examination.

3. Eligibility

Students who passed out /studying at degree and post degree level in Podar college or in other colleges, belonging to SC/ST/ OBC (non-creamy layer) and Minority communities will be considered eligible for assistance under this scheme. The students belonging to open category from economically weaker sections and physically challenged may also avail of this facility.

4. How to apply

Applications are available in the Library of R.A. Podar College of Commerce & Economics, Matunga, Mumbai-19. Students can obtain the **Enrolment Form** which is available free of cost by showing ID card of their respective colleges. Before filling up the said form, students must read the **Rules and Conditions** given on reverse side of the enrolment form and submit the same with attested copies of following documents. Students are required to submit the dully filled in application forms on or before 15th February 2017.
